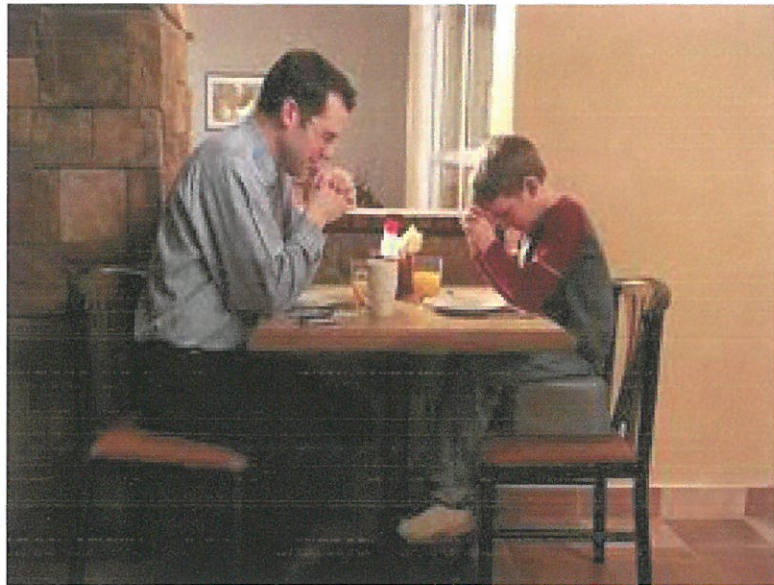
Raising our children to be faithful Catholic Disciples of the Lord is a parents' sole responsibility. The Church is an instrument to help the parent on the journey.



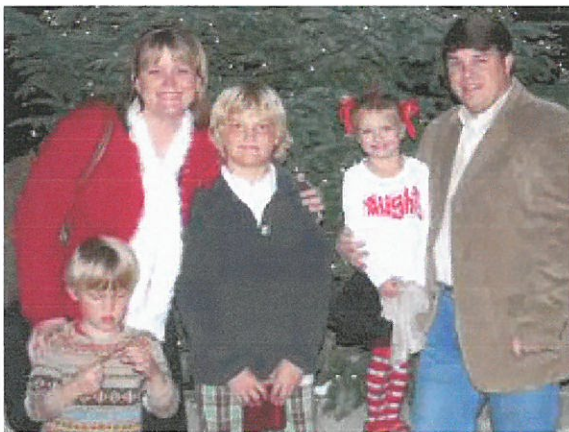
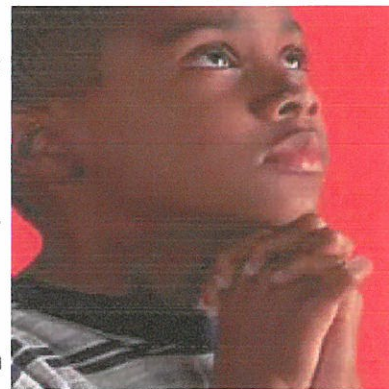
We at Christ the Servant believe:
